# Map to St. Mary's Hall

St. Mary's Hall is located at 9401 Starcrest, approximately 1 mile north of Loop 410 (Northside San Antonio). **THIS IS NOT ST. MARY'S UNIVERSITY!**

**From the East**—Take Loop 410 around to the Starcrest Exit. Turn Right onto Starcrest and travel approximately 1 mile north. Starcrest dead-ends at St. Mary's Hall.

**From the West**- Take Loop 410 around to the Starcrest Exit. Turn Left onto Starcrest, and cross over the overpass. You will now travel approximately 1 mile north. Starcrest dead-ends at St. Mary's Hall.
